We acknowledge and accept that each of us is unique and has special gifts from the Holy Spirit.

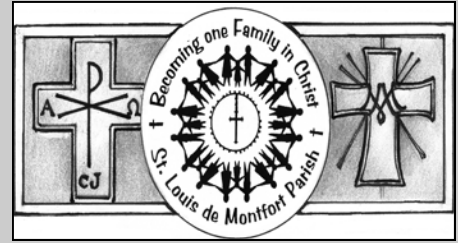
