We wish to nurture, develop and share these gifts within and for the Body of Christ.

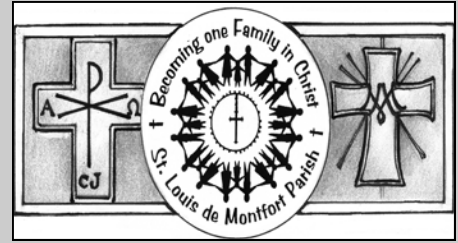
Having been called by Baptism into that Body,

**What can I do as a parent following a trauma?**

Establish a sense of safety and security. It is essential that children feel protected, safe and secure in the aftermath of a trauma. Ensure that all basic needs are met, including love, care, and physical closeness. Spend extra time to let children know that someone will nurture and protect them. Children will need a lot of comforting and reassurance. **TRIP TO EGYPT AND TURKEY**

There is still time to sign up for the trip. However, there is a \$100 discount now until Jan.7, 2014. The trip is a ten-day trip in Oct. 2014 and includes a 3-day boat trip to the islands that St. Paul visited. The trip, for **two people** would cost \$7142\*; that includes bus to LAX and back; air fare, hotels, tour bus with guide and most meals. For a single person the cost would be \$3571\*.
