We wish to nurture, develop and share these gifts within and for the Body of Christ.

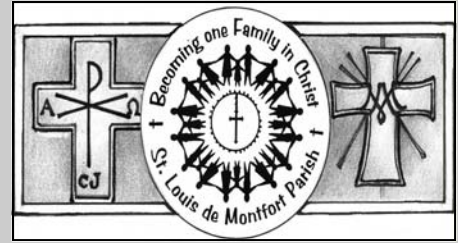

FACE PAINTING—we still need one more face painter to liven up the faces of our little ones. If you know of anyone that can do this, please have them email Debbie LeBard.

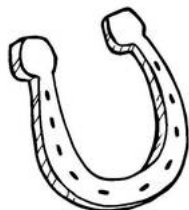
