## LAUDA ZION (sequence for Corpus Christi by St Thomas Aquinas)

Sion, lift up thy voice and sing:

Thank You for satisfying our hunger and quenching our thirst! Because of You, we are made whole, because of Your sacrifice we are free! Precious Lamb, we do not take what You did for us for granted, Amen.

**John 6:35**

Dear Lord, You sent Your Son as the living bread that came down out of heaven; You promised that if anyone eats of this bread, they will live forever; and the bread also which You gave for the life of the world was Your flesh. Father, I am eternally grateful for the sacrifice that You made. You gave Yourself for the world, and You would do it all over again even if it was only to save me! I love You Lord, Amen.
