Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ October 17, 2021



Fr. Aidan Writes: Pope Francis and world Faith leaders have been asking us to pray for the serious issues facing the environment as we lead up to the COP26 conference in Glasgow. His very challenging, yet beautiful, encyclical, *Laudato Si*, focuses the Church's, and the world's, attention on these real issues facing us all and our beautiful home on this blue marble in space.

Our need to take these matters seriously stems from the fact that we must be true to God's created intent for us to be stewards of His creation. Notice the use of "His"! Firstly, the whole of creation is God's gift to us and we are really misusing His gift. Secondly, as Eucharistic people we are supposed to live our lives in a thankful manner for all His graces and gifts. Mother earth is suffering because of our greed and the arrogance of our human place in this created order.

In Genesis, we read human kind was given "dominion" over all of creation. This is a dangerous word in translation because it implies unlimited power to do what we want with God's creation. This is not what it means. When we look at the whole of the Old Testament true Kingship is compassionate, merciful, wise, providential and socially responsible with respect for the land God gave the Israelites; not domineering.

Here in the parish we take the little steps we can do locally. Lighting is converted to LED, sprinklers are adjusted to be more efficient, waste is sorted into recyclable and non, there is very little food waste and we use heating sparingly, etc.

I remember 25 years ago in Santa Barbara, the LA times ran an article that if everyone put one brick in every toilet cistern it would save a litre of water each flush; that accumulated to solving LA's water shortage! So our little bits can help if we all overcome our prejudices, some of our arrogance of ignorance and our received political view-points. Remember we are to be thankful stewards of God's creative gift to us...His gift...His...

Keep 'em Safe

Escalating red flags in an adult's behavior

In most abuse cases, the victim knows the offender. Offenders go to great lengths to ensure that they are not strangers, often spending months or even years hiding in plain sight. Parents should be aware of a few red flags that range from obvious to subtle, and usually indicate a more sinister relationship at work between an offender and potential victims. Some obvious signs include telling children dirty jokes or showing them pornography. More subtle signs could be an adult who wrestles or tickles often, wants to be alone with children, gives gifts frequently, or encourages children to keep secrets. Manténgase atento al aumento de señales de alerta en el comportamiento de un adulto

En la mayoría de los casos de abuso, la víctima conoce al agresor. Los delincuentes hacen todo lo posible para asegurarse de que no sean considerados extraños, y a menudo pasan meses o incluso años ocultos a la vista. Los padres de familia deben estar al tanto de algunas señales de alerta que van de obvias a sutiles y, por lo general, indican una relación más siniestra de un delincuente con respecto a las víctimas potenciales. Algunas señales obvias incluyen contarles chistes sucios a los niños o mostrarles pornografía. Los signos más sutiles podrían ser un adulto que lucha o hace cosquillas a menudo, quiere estar solo con los niños, les da regalos con frecuencia o anima a los niños a guardar secretos. 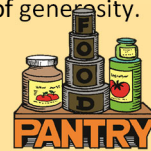

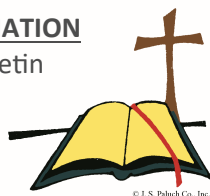
