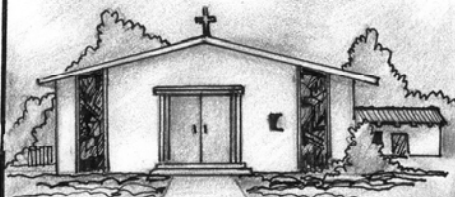

We acknowledge and accept that each of us is unique and has special gifts from the Holy Spirit.

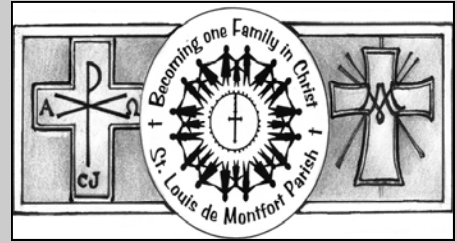
We wish to nurture, develop and share these gifts within and for the Body of Christ.

DID YOU KNOW? . Playing It Safe When the Heat Is On

The hottest months of summer are here, and many children will be playing sports and participating in other activities outdoors. Make sure their summer camp supervisors and coaches know how to recognize and properly treat the signs of heat-related problems in children, including confusion; dilated pupils; dizziness; fainting; headache; heavy perspiration; nausea; pale and moist or hot, dry skin; weak pulse; and weakness. Every summer sports program for children should have rules for playing it safe when the heat is on.
