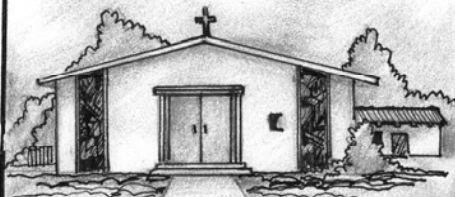

We acknowledge and accept that each of us is unique and has special gifts from the Holy Spirit.

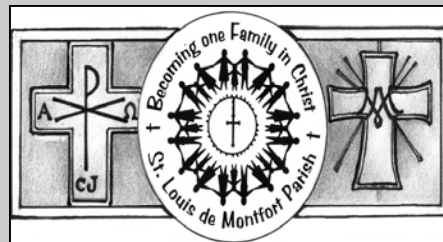
We wish to nurture, develop and share these gifts within and for the Body of Christ.
