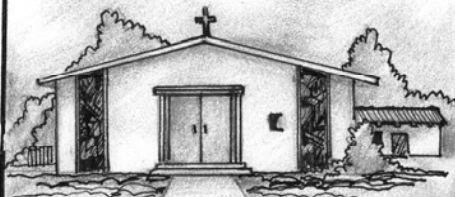

We acknowledge and accept that each of us is unique and has special gifts from the Holy Spirit.

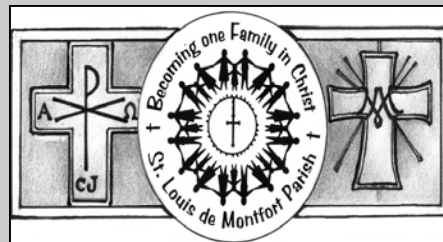
We wish to nurture, develop and share these gifts within and for the Body of Christ.

Did you know that elderly people (65 years and older), infants and children and people with chronic medical conditions are more prone to heat stress. Keep in mind that air-conditioning is the number one protective factor against heat-related illness and death. During conditions of extreme heat, spend time in locations with air-conditioning such as shopping malls, public libraries, or public health sponsored heat-relief shelters in your area. Get informed. Listen to local news and weather channels or contact your local public health department during extreme heat conditions for health and safety updates. Manténgase informado. Escuche las noticias respecto al clima o contacte a la oficina local del departamento de salud para actualizaciones de seguridad y salud. Tome bebidas frías sin alcohol e incremente su consumo de líquidos, sin importar el nivel de su actividad física.
