We wish to nurture, develop and share these gifts within and for the Body of Christ.

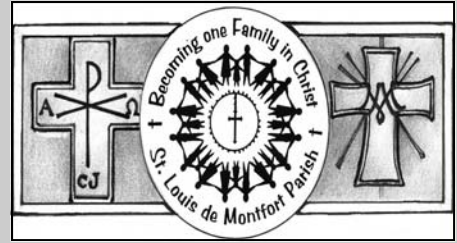

**BE AWARE YOU COULD BE SCAMMED!!**

The IRS is issuing the following warning: "The IRS has issued another strong warning for consumers to guard against sophisticated and aggressive phone scams targeting taxpayers, including recent immigrants, as reported incidents of this crime continue to rise nationwide. The IRS will always send taxpayers written notifications of any tax due via the U.S. mail. The IRS NEVER asks for credit card, debit card or prepaid information over the telephone. Potential victims may be told they are entitled to big refunds, or that they owe money that must be paid immediately. IF you refuse the first time. IF you get a call and if you know you owe taxes or think you might, call the IRS at 1.800.829.1040. If you know you do not owe any taxes then call and report the incident to the Treasury Inspector General for Tax Administration at 1.800.366.4484. **DID YOU KNOW? Learn to stop inappropriate activity before it happens**

Teach your child to respect the word “stop!” Teach your preschooler that “stop” means “stop,” and that your child has the right to stop people from touching his or her body. Obviously, exceptions will have to be made for doctors and parents, but even parents must listen when a child doesn’t want to be tickled or hugged anymore. Reinforcing this excellent lesson gives your child the power to recognize -- and to stop -- “bad touching” by others if it should happen.
