We wish to nurture, develop and share these gifts within and for the Body of Christ.

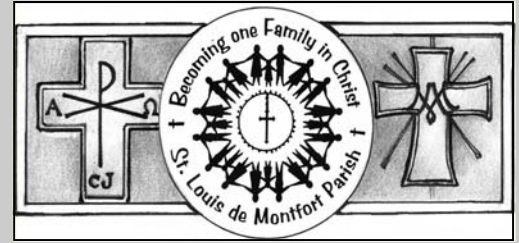
